- 1.) The number of 4-person teams will be limited to 40. Entry deadline is the earlier of Oct 15th, 2007 or receipt of the first 40 teams' entry form and entry fee of \$700. Golf carts are included this year with registration.
- 2.) Each team member will be required to sign a waiver of liability at registration. Substitutions will be accepted until registration closes.
- 3.) The designated team captain on the entry form will be responsible for distributing a copy of the Rules and Regulations to each member of the team for their review and acceptance.
- 4.) Two teams will be assigned to each station. Each team to pull and score for each other.
- 5.) Registration will open on Monday, October 22th at 10:00 am and close at 12:00 noon. Warm-up/Shooting Games begins at 10:30 am and the tournament will begin at 12:30 pm. ***Liability Waivers must be signed and registered prior to all shooting activities.***
- 6.) Lunch, beverages, door prizes and awards are included in the entry fee.
- 7.) Safety is of the utmost importance, and therefore, the consumption of alcoholic beverages will not be permitted until after all shooting has been completed. Ear and eye protection are required. Your support is appreciated.
- 8.) Door prizes will be awarded following the tournament while the scores are being finalized. **You must be present to receive a door prize.**
